## 2023 Event Rules:

- 1. The Shelby Barbacoa will be held on July 21st (starting at 12:01 am).
- Competitors must cook everything on-site and can start anytime they wish on or after 12:01 am on the morning of July 21st.
- The categories will be as follows: Baby Back Ribs, Beef Brisket, Pulled Pork,
  Open Class, Armadillo Eggs, and People's Choice (voted on by paying
  spectators).
- 4. The judging will start at 4:00 pm and awards will start around 5:00 pm. A panel of judges will determine the winner of each category. All results are final.
- 5. \$50 entry fee (a competitor can do one or all of the categories for \$50)
- 6. 4-H and FFA teams can enter for FREE (must comprise of 4-H or FFA members only; parents may offer guidance, but will not be competing)
- 7. The competitors must have enough to give small samples to the public.
- 8. The meat and all supplies are the responsibility of the competitors.
- \$10 wristbands will be sold to the public, giving them access to samples and a chance to vote for the People Choice award.
- 10. Paper boats, napkins, and utensils will be provided for public sampling.
- 11. Proceeds will go to the Shelby FFA Chapter.
- 12. Prizes will be \$200 for 1st place in each category and a plaque.
